

PUBLIC CONSULTATION ON THE DRAFT DECREE ESTABLISHING THE LEGAL FRAMEWORK FOR PARTICIPATION FINANCE

DEADLINE EXTENDED

The deadline for the public consultation on the draft Decree establishing the legal framework for participation finance has been extended until May 15, 2025.

Participation finance represents a viable and feasible alternative to conventional banking, with rising implementation worldwide, which renders various financial products and services rooted in specific principles.

Such principles include the prohibition of interest (usury); non-participation in contracts exposed to excessive risks or business uncertainty; the prohibition of investment in forbidden activities; and the avoidance of speculation.

Stakeholder engagement is indispensable to refine the draft Decree and, in particular, establish a clear, effective, and robust regulatory framework tailored to the specific context of Mozambique. We look forward to your participation!
