

COMMUNIQUÉ

As provided for in Article 56 (2) of Law No. 1/92, of January 3, the Banco de Moçambique shall hold its 47th Advisory Board meeting on November 2 to 4, 2022, in Beira city.

The Advisory Board of the Banco de Moçambique is an extended consultation body of the Board of Directors, which meets regularly once a year and extraordinarily whenever convened by the Governor of the Bank, for the following purposes: addressing matters concerning the organization and operation of the Bank; attending to matters that strictly concern the Board of Directors; and providing an activity overview and planning for future actions.

In this light, the first two days, November 2 and 3, shall be reserved for the presentation and review of internal matters, and the third day, November 4, for the open session presentation and discussion of a topic of public interest.

In this context, this year the public discussion topic is “**Challenges and Opportunities in the Sugar Industry of Mozambique: The Case of Sofala province**”.
